Key Comments

- For the vast majority of areas Dore data is above the 2014 National Figures Data.
- 3 levels progress for reading from KS1 for reading is an area where Dore's figures are slightly lower, this is due to the large numbers of Level 3 pupils at Key Stage 1 and the difficulty that comes with trying to convert these to a Level 6 (The National Figure for achieving a Level 6 is 0%).
- 2 levels progress or more from KS1 for writing is the other area where Dore's figure drops slightly below the national figures – The reason for this data being lower than expected is mainly due to children who have come new to the school, where we have missing data, therefore children have to be considered a 3b at KS1.
- Very exciting news – of the children who sat the SATs tests all pupils achieved level 4 or above in Maths.

NB – 2 children with very particular needs did not sit the tests therefore are not included within these percentages – these two children contribute to 3.1%
