## **Dore Kids Club Ltd**

Dore Kids Club Ltd. offers an after school play and care service for children who attend Dore Primary School. The club operates between 3:15pm and 5:45pm each evening in term time.

The Club is registered with Ofsted to offer after school care for 35 children.

The club's aim is to offer parents a reliable and professional childcare service at a reasonable cost. The Club is self-financing and run on a non-profit making basis.

The Club accepts childcare vouchers and supports flexible payment methods within the term of invoice. Fees are currently charged at £6.50 per day.

## **Information for Parents**

The Club is held in the Junior School Hall and has extensive use of the school outdoor play facilities.

Staff are fully qualified and trained in line with child Ofsted requirements (this includes NVQ level qualified staff, first aid, health and safety and food hygiene)

A healthy snack is provided for children which includes a choice of fresh fruit and vegetables. Fresh water is available at all times.

Special dietary requirements are respected and catered for.

The outdoor play area is fully staffed at all times to facilitate a fun and safe environment for your children.

## **What can Dore Kids Club offer your child?**

We offer a wide range of imaginative indoor and outdoor activities which are tailored to the children's ages.

Indoor activities include table-top arts and crafts, board games, dressing up, playstation and DS games, snooker and group activities and games. A television is available to watch DVDs.

There is also a quiet corner which allows children to relax and take advantage of a small library.

Outdoor play is actively encouraged. Children are required to wear a tabard when playing outdoors and are fully supervised at all times. The club has access to the Jungle Gym and amphitheatre as well as the school playing fields, and provides the games equipment to encourage play.

## How do I get a place for my child?

Places are available to any child attending Dore Primary School.

Parents can drop by and talk to the Manager about having a taster session and availability on the days required.

It is possible to register your child in advance to allow you to plan for your child's transition to the school or to manage your future work commitments.

## The Committee and Management of the Club

The Club is run by a voluntary management committee of parents who meet regularly to ensure

- the smooth running of the club
- health and safety requirements are met
- education and support for the staff in line with Ofsted
- the financial management and health of the company
- continuous liaison with the school and school management team

It is managed on a day to day basis by the Manager supported by a Deputy Manager.
