

One World Week: Week beginning the 16th October 2017

To encourage our children to be global citizens, every class in the school has a class country. China is the country for our class.

During One World Week, Y3E will be having a TASC (Thinking Actively in a Social Context) afternoon.

The Brief: To produce a new atlas page all about China.

In order to be able to make the atlas in One World Week, we are asking that you do some research (not the finished product!) at home.

We have included some ideas of activities that you could complete below (just choose two or three). Or you could be creative and present your learning in a different way.

1. Draw an outline of Asia and mark on China.
2. Clearly label the capital city (correct spelling).
3. Draw the flag.
4. Find out about what is produced (the products) in your country (e.g. copper, wheat, wine). Can you find or draw pictures?
5. Which language is spoken? Can you research any Chinese letters?
6. Find out about the climate/weather.
7. Which animals can be found there? Can you find or draw pictures?
8. Are there any important geographical features e.g. rivers, mountains?
9. Any other information which interests you.



You might like to collect your research together in a plastic wallet or envelope. Please label clearly with your name.
