

Y3 will be exploring a new topic after half term called Veni Vidi Vici. It is based on the Romans and their culture. Over the holidays, it may be helpful if your child does one of the activities suggested to help them become familiar with the Romans. However, this is optional.

Below are some suggestions of potential tasks the children can do:

Read a Roman Myth

Your child could read a Roman myth. There are many online websites that provide child friendly myths that the children can read. They could make notes or produce a cartoon strip retelling the story. (We ask that you don't read Perseus and Medusa as we will be exploring this myth in English).

Read About a Roman God

Your child could read and create a fact file about the Roman gods. These can be found on child websites online. Your child could comment on the god's appearance, personality and mythical powers.

Read About the Rulers of the Romans

Your child could read about the rulers of Rome, for example Caesar. They could create a portrait of the ruler, making notes about their qualities or characteristics, for example if they were a bad ruler and why.
