Dear parents and carers,

We have an exciting trip coming up the start of the next half term, which we would like to give you early notice of.

As part of our topic relating to rivers, we will be taking Year 4/5 to the nearby Oldhay Brook to gather some empirical data to help children deepen their geographical understanding. We will walk from school to the watercourse and the children will be supervised by Dore staff in adult led groups as they spend the morning fully exploring a section of the river. We will be back in school for lunchtime. Children should arrive at school as per a normal day at **8:40am** and can be picked up at the normal time of 3:15pm.

Snack and Water

On the day of the trip children can bring a small snack as they normally do for break time. Obviously, any packaging or waste must be carried back to school to be disposed of properly. As we are walking, it is advisable for all children to bring a named water bottle with them in order to stay hydrated.

Clothing

On the day, children can wear any comfortable clothing that is suitable for a day's outdoor activities. In addition, please send your child to school on the day of the trip wearing comfy, closed toe shoes. If the weather on the day is inclement, a waterproof coat will be required.
