Dear Parents and Carers,



I write on behalf of the Parent Road Safety and Travel Group for Dore Primary School School Change Team. Welcome back to Spring term!

As a group, we always encourage good practice in road safety and travel to and from school, sensible parking, and respect for others. We will continue to support the school and local community with this aim.

Last term the school experienced a significant increase in road safety and travel incidents around the school's 3 entrances. This was unacceptable. **THIS TERM**, our parent group, as well as other parents and local residents, **WILL REPORT** all similar incidents to the school, the local authority and police where necessary. This will include car registration details and may include photographic evidence which are requested.

We would urge everyone to be especially mindful of the convenience of nearby residents, courtesy and respect for others at drop off and pick up and sensible parking away well away from school entrances.

Please **DO NOT**

- **BLOCK** resident driveways or **PARK NEAR** the school crossing patrol
- **STOP** or **PARK** on the yellow zig zag lines
- **PARK** close to the school entrances

Please **DO**

- Try to walk to school whenever possible
- Keep your **SPEED DOWN** to 20mph
- **PARK** and **STRIDE** in one of the village pubs
- Wear something **BRIGHT** to be seen by others

Thankfully, we have few serious accidents around the school, but increases in the incidents witnessed and reported last term will increase this risk. None of us want to have to report any future accidents around the school. Please have a safe term.
