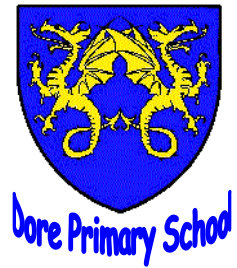


TEAM Dore
