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Sports Day 2018 – The ‘Stronger Together’ Games **Friday 22nd June**

Dear Parents / Carers,

I am pleased to inform you that this year's Sports Day will again be a whole-school event. The decision to have another whole-school sports day was made based on the very positive feedback we have received regarding the last six events.

This year we will be celebrating our school values of resilience, resourcefulness, creativity and kindness. Children will once again wear coloured t-shirts to denote their team. The shirt design uses the reef knot, representing joining two pieces of rope together to make a strong, longer piece.

Siblings will, as always, be in the same team.

The day will start with an opening ceremony at around 9:00. Children will then rotate round seven different 'zones', where they will have the opportunity to try out different sports in a collaborative atmosphere.

The family picnic will be taking place as usual on Sports Day, at around 12:15. Children will be asked to return to class at around 1pm, in order to be registered for the afternoon session.

To help the school kitchen, on FRIDAY 15TH JUNE, children will be asked to make a choice of lunch from home or a school packed lunch of ham or cheese sandwich for Sports Day. Please discuss this with your child so they can let their teacher know their choice. There will be no school hot dinners on Sports Day.

The event should finish in time for the end of the school day, when children will return to their classes for collection. **In the event of poor weather during the day, children must return to classes.** A decision will be made by the school leadership team as to whether children resume the sports, or remain in classes. Parents will be informed of any such decisions via text message.

Families are of course welcome to spend as much of the day watching the events as they would like to. In line with the school policy dogs must not be brought to this very busy event.

The Dore Parents Association have again very kindly agreed to organise and distribute t-shirts for children to wear. It was agreed we would continue with t-shirts by the parents, governors and staff who attended the School Change meeting last autumn. The DPA recognise and appreciate the continued generosity of parental contributions to Dore Primary and the benefit this brings to every child. In an attempt to make funds go further, we are asking that parents contribute £3.50 towards the cost of each shirt. These t-shirts can then be used as part of your child's PE kit next year. If you are able to contribute, it would be greatly appreciated. For the last five years the DPA has subsidised the cost of these t-shirts, as some families have opted not to pay for the shirt. We do feel that as well as being good value and attractive, the t-shirts are vital to this whole-school event as they allow transitions between zones to take place quickly, as children and teachers simply have to follow their colour.

Please make a payment of £3.50 via SQUIDPAY for your child's t shirt prior to Sports Day.
