Dear Parents / Carers,

I am pleased to inform you that this year's Sports Day will again be a whole-school event. This year we will be celebrating our local area and some of the activities that take place where we live <https://www.theoutdoorcity.co.uk/>. Many of the events this year will link with the outdoor learning and forest school programme we have been delivering in school this year, with children making some of the items used in their outdoor learning sessions.

Children will once again wear coloured t-shirts (handed out on the day) to denote their team. Siblings will, as always, be in the same team.

The day will start with an opening ceremony at around 9:00. Children will then rotate round seven different zones, where they will have the opportunity to try out different sports in a collaborative atmosphere.

The family picnic will be taking place as usual on Sports Day, at around 12:15. Children will be asked to return to class at around 1pm, in order to be registered for the afternoon session.

To help the school kitchen, on FRIDAY 14th JUNE (Tues 11th for Y6 due to residential), children will be asked to make a choice of lunch from home or a school packed lunch of ham or cheese sandwich for Sports Day. Please discuss this with your child so they can let their teacher know their choice. There will be no school hot dinners on Sports Day.

The event should finish in time for the end of the school day, when children will return to their classes for collection. **In the event of poor weather during the day, children must return to classes.** A decision will then be made by the school leadership team as to whether children resume the sports or remain in classes. Parents will be informed of any such decisions via text message.

Families are of course welcome to spend as much of the day watching the events as they would like to. In line with the school policy dogs must not be brought to this very busy event.

The Dore Parents Association are once again organising and distribute t-shirts for children to wear - a huge undertaking and one we are very thankful to them for taking on. The DPA recognise and appreciate the continued generosity of parental contributions to Dore Primary and the benefit this brings to every child. In an attempt to make funds go further, we are asking that parents contribute £3.50 towards the cost of each shirt. For the last six years the DPA has subsidised the cost of these t-shirts, as some families have opted not to pay for the shirt. These t-shirts can then be used as part of your child's PE kit next year. We feel that as well as being good value and attractive, the t-shirts are vital to this whole-school event as they allow transitions between zones to take place quickly, as children and teachers simply have to follow their colour.

The DPA's famous 'Brew Army' will be selling refreshments for adults during the day.


Please make a payment of £3.50 via SQUID for your child's t shirt prior to Sports Day.
