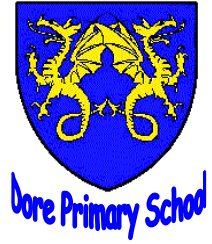


“DORE 20 is PLENTY”



Voluntary pledge to reduce speed to 20mph on school roads to protect our children.

Following recent concerns regarding driving and parking around Dore Primary School we would like to encourage the whole community of Dore to reduce their driving speed to 20mph on Furniss Avenue, Church Lane and the top of Bushey Wood Road.

This voluntary pledge will be the start of an ongoing awareness campaign aimed at the whole community to help make “20 is plenty in Dore” in order to protect our children from road accidents.

Britain has the highest percentage of pedestrian road fatalities in Europe. More than half occur on roads with 30mph limits. Speed limits on our urban roads are 60% higher than Europe.

Britain has one of the lowest levels of children walking or cycling to school in Europe.

British parents consistently blame traffic speed as the main reason why their children are not allowed to cycle or walk to school.

Lowering speed limits to 20mph has been found to decrease child pedestrian accidents by 70%
