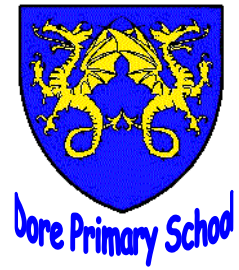

ROAD SAFETY WEEK

As we do each year and in between annual National Awareness Weeks, we are working hard to remind our parents and the local community about **SAFE DRIVING** and **PARKING** in order to **PROTECT** our children.

In 2013-2014 the Governing Body invested in the Health and Safety of our children by financing extra road signage which authorizes the police and community officers to **BOOK** cars/drivers that drop off (even stop) on the zig zag yellow lines at the three school entrances.

This initially had a very good effect and there was less parking which blocks the view of children crossing and the crossing warden on Furniss Avenue. There is still an improvement **BUT** a few cars have started the 'quick drop' again. This is illegal. If you have registration numbers of cars that do this, please let the Headteacher know. Thank you 😊

This year we have bought a **MIGHTY** banner which is displayed at the top of Furniss Avenue, reminding all that we would **LOVE** to have a voluntary pledge from local drivers to drive at 20 m.p.h on roads in the village and around the schools. Have you signed the 20 m.p.h. pledge?

REMEMBER – local businesses have offered parking in their car-park so that cars are off the road and there is a short **PARK** and **STRIDE**.

Whenever possible please **WALK** to school or Park at a **DISTANCE**.
